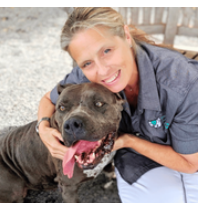

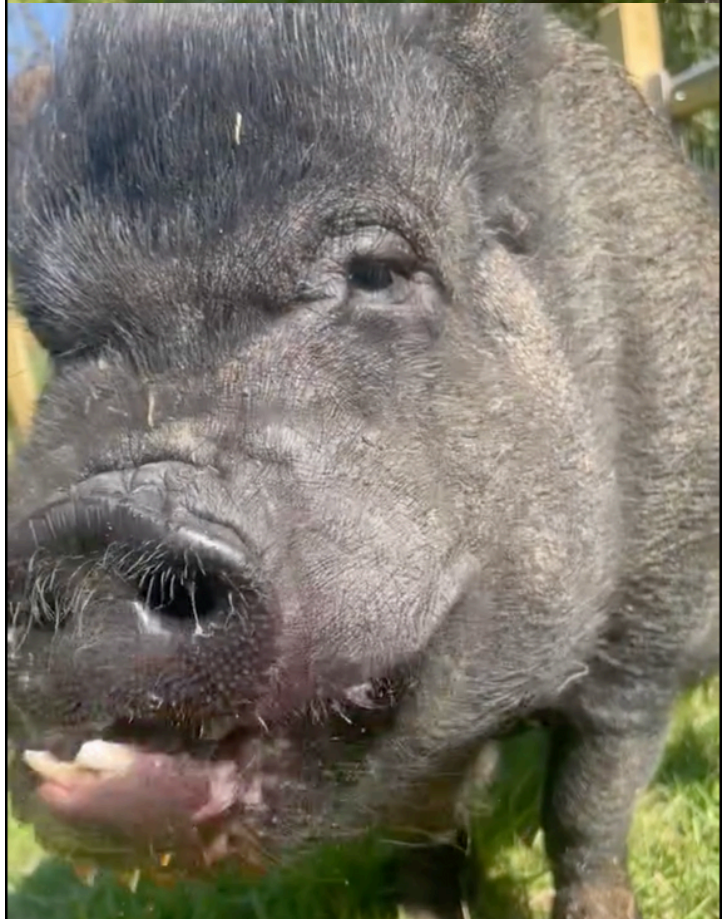
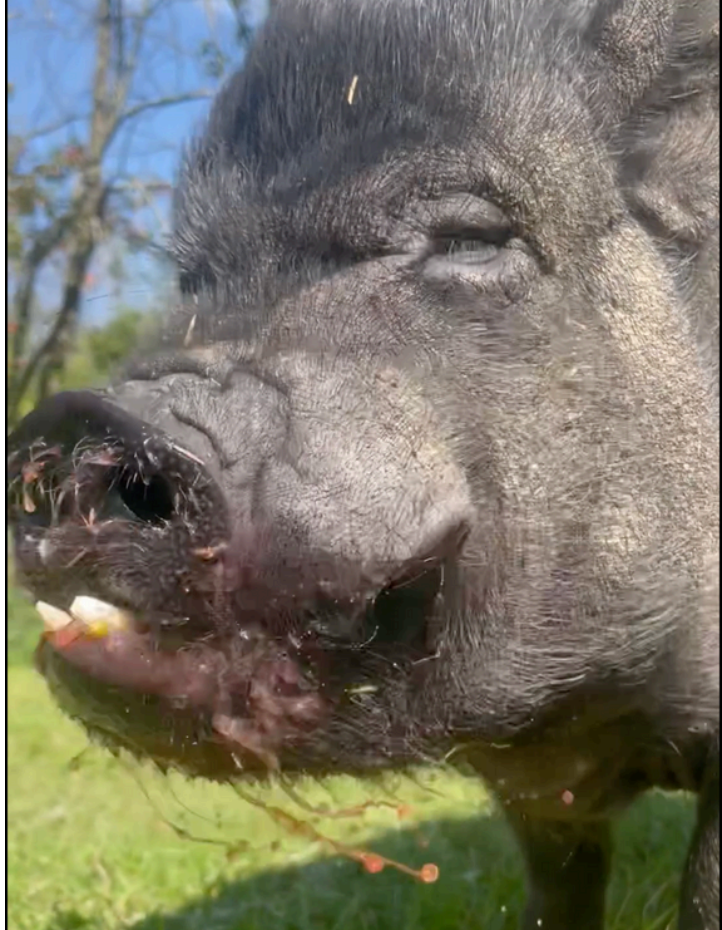
GRANT IN ACTION

THE POWER OF PERSONALIZED IMPACT GRANTS

Our Grant Makers Initiative (GMI) is inspired by the human-animal bond and is designed to transform traditional giving into a personal partnership. This initiative empowers you to have a direct impact by funding essential medical care and rehabilitation for animals in dire need.

We aim to create 25 medical grants and 2 program development grants this year, with a funding target of \$100,000. This goal is ambitious but crucial; by uniting our efforts, we can directly address the needs of animals in crisis and strengthen the human-animal bond within our community.

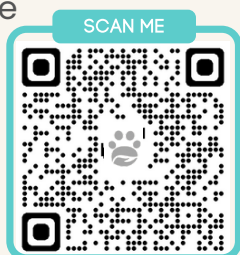
